 number of completeness, fullness, or perfection
 - What is the seven spirits (or seven fold spirit) in 1:4?
 - The perfect Holy Spirit
 - (Isaiah 11:2, 7 things said about the Spirit)
 - Someone tell me the meaning of one of the descriptions of Jesus' appearance in 1:12-16.
 - What three offices or positions does Jesus' appearance bring to mind?
 - Priest, King, Judge
 - What are the seven golden lamp stands?
 - the seven churches
 - Why do you think the churches are represented by lamp stands?
 - Light of the world, connection with Israel in the OT/Jewish Tradition that was represented by a lamp stand (Zechariah 4)
 - Who are the "angels of the seven churches?"
 - Most likely heavenly angels that guard the churches or represent them in heaven
 - Why do you think this was written to seven churches?
 - written to real churches, but also symbolizes this message is for the whole church at all times
- Overview of the Seven Churches
 - Every Church has a reference to the vision of Jesus in Chapter 1
 - Ephesus: <u>Seven stars/lampstands</u>
 - Smyrna: First/last, dead/came to life
 - Pergamum: <u>Double-edged Sword</u>
 - Thyatira: <u>Flaming Eyes/feet like bronze</u>
 - Sardis: <u>Seven spirits/stars</u>

- Philadelphia: <u>Holy/keys</u>
- Laodicea: <u>Faithful witness (1:5)</u>
- Most of the churches have serious problems
 - Exceptions: Smyrna and Philadelphia
- Jesus' messages to the churches has themes that are further explored in the book.
 - <u>False synagogue</u> (2:9, 3:9) contrasted with the <u>Lion</u> of the Tribe of Judah and the <u>true Israel</u> (5:5-10; 7:4-8)
 - "<u>Ten day trial</u>" (2:10) seems like the "<u>little while</u>" in (6:9-17)
 - <u>Spiritual protection</u> (3:10) by a <u>divine name</u> (2:17; 3:12) much like the <u>Spiritually sealed</u> (7; 14:1)
 - Many more
- The churches form a "chiastic structure"
 - Outside two about to cease being a church
 - next two in have <u>no weaknesses</u> and are <u>encouraged</u>
 - The middle three are mixed
 - Emphasis usually lies in the outside 2
 - Point: Churches are in serious trouble
 - Insofar as 7 churches represent the church universal:
 - Churches are usually <u>not very healthy</u>
 - But always a few that stand out like <u>Smyrna</u> and <u>Philadelphia</u>
 - Purpose of this (for them and for us): <u>stay alert, don't</u> compromise, shake those awake who are compromising the faith, to stay faithful in our witness and endure.
- 2 things:
 - These letters weren't just for churches back then.
 - This book isn't just about things that are going to happen.
 - already-not yet
