- Text: Revelation 2:8-11
- Review:
 - What lessons did we learn from the church in Ephesus?
 - We must protect against false teaching
 - We must defend the truth of the gospel
 - We must never stop <u>loving</u> God and one another.
 - We must never stop sharing the good news of Jesus.
- Background on Smyrna
 - Smyrna had a very large population of Jews
 - Like most other places in Asia Minor, <u>Emperor Worship</u> was a normal part of everyday life.
 - It may have been necessary to participate in emperor worship just to <u>have a job.</u>
 - At this point in history, <u>Jews</u> were distancing themselves from Christians more and more.
- The Letter
 - v. 8 What from the vision of Jesus in chapter one can you find in this letter?
 - First and the last, dead and came to life
 - What was Smyrna doing right?
 - They were enduring persecution
 - What was Smyrna doing wrong?
 - Jesus says nothing against them!
 - v. 9 What challenge was the church in Smyrna facing? - persecution from Jews and Romans
 - v. 9 How can they both be in poverty and be rich? *Materially poor, Spiritually rich*
 - v. 9 What do you think is meant by "those who say they are Jews and are not"?
 - Ethnically they were Jews, but didn't worship God or his Messiah

- Synagogue of satan: Satan=false accuser, making false accusations against the church
- Who is the true Israel? Who are the true "children of Abraham?"
 - Galatians 3:7, 29
 - Romans 4:11-17 (cf. Ephesians 2:11-22)
- Do not be afraid/first and the last= Isaiah 41:4, 8-10
 - The church is the fulfillment of the promises made to Israel.
 - Keep that in mind as we continue to go through the book.
- Why is their affliction described as only for "ten days"?
 - Daniel 1:12; Symbolic for a "short time"
- What does the "crown of life" symbolize?
 - Same thing as the "tree of life" (v. 7): Eternal life
- Final Thoughts
 - Connect of the Jesus Vision to their circumstances
 - Tell story of Polycarp
 - (Disciple of John, Bishop of Smyrna, died at 86 years old, could have been a part of the church at Smyrna when this very letter was read)

To the Church at Pergamum

- Background on Pergamum
 - Was the center of <u>emperor worship</u> in this region
 - Was the first city in Asia Minor build a <u>temple</u> to a Roman ruler (Augustus)
 - Also a center of worship for many <u>false Gods</u>
- The Letter
 - v. 12What from the vision of Jesus in chapter one can you find in this letter?
 - Double edged sword
 - What was Pergamum doing right?

- Holding on to their faith, enduring persecution
- What has Pergamum done wrong?
 - holding to the teaching of "Balaam" and the "Nicolaitans"
- What does that mean?
 - Numbers 22-25; 31:16: giving in to social pressures and committing sin
- What does Jesus threaten will happen to those who do not repent? What does that mean?
 - Fight against them with the sword of my mouth: receive same fate as Jesus' enemies (Revelation 19:15)
- What do the hidden manna, white stone, and new name symbolize?
 - Same as vv. 7, 11: Eternal life
- What is meant by "let anyone who has ears to hear listen"?
 - Use in the OT by prophets, used by Jesus when telling parables, Message is designed to enlighten some and blind others.
